- 1. Game Time
 - a. There is no grace period to game start time, game should start on time
 - b. Toss should be conducted 5 minutes before the game start time
 - c. Any delay should result in reduction in overs
 - d. Game should complete in allotted 80 minutes with 5-minute break between innings
- 2. Game Result
 - a. If a game (except finals) result is Tie, then winner will be decided based on:
 - i. Team with most boundaries in the match
 - ii. If still equal, a count back from the final ball shall be conducted. The team with higher scoring delivery shall be the winner
 - b. For finals, if the game is tie, then a Super Over will be played, one over per side with 3 batsmen. After Super Over if it's still a tie, then winner will be decided based on 2.a using combined score of main match and Super Over
- 3. Other Guidelines
 - a. No rolling 1d between cones at the leg umpire side. Only direct hit over the rope between the cones is 1d
 - b. Maximum 9 players per team
 - c. Maximum 10 overs per inning
 - d. For an inning with 9-10 overs, maximum 2 overs per bowler with an exception of 2 bowlers can be allowed 3 overs.
 - e. If an innings is played with reduced overs of <=8 overs, then maximum 2 overs per bowler allowed
 - f. Where not mentioned HCC rules will be followed
